MISSISSIPPI COSMETOLOGY AND BARBERING ASSOCIATION EXECUTIVE BOARD DUTIES AND POWERS OF OFFICERS

*** At the expiration of his or her term, each officer and director shall forthwith return to the Association all books, papers, and records which were delivered to him or her during his or her term of office in connection with the performance of duties.

DIRECTORS

To be considered as a Director of the MCBA Executive Board, you must be an active member in Good Standing of MCBA for at least one year prior to running for Director.

You must have leadership aspirations, and willingness to assume any leadership positions that are asked of you.

The role of the Directors is to learn all the officer positions of the Executive Board to prepare you to move up in leadership for eventually assuming the President's position.

To achieve this, each Director will be assigned to an officer as a Protégé and support person.

All Directors must work with the Membership Chair to contact all members and potential members in your area. You should always be aware of how many members we have, and what area they are in.

All Directors must work hand in hand with the Show Director to learn exactly what is involved in putting together a show or special event.

All Directors must attend all the Executive Board Meetings, and all show events.
